Eligibility: Open to all. Wheelchair Users must meet minimum handicap rule. Standing
Dancers must be able to perform as able-bodied dancers. It is permissible to
replace a wheelchair user with a standing dancer to allow the disabled to continue
to compete. Please notify judges prior to event.

Time Limit: A minimum of one and a half minutes for Waltz, Tango, Quickstep, Samba,
Rumba and a minimum of 1 minute for Viennese Waltz.

Space: 800 sq. metres in total. Approx. 400sq. metres of dance floor.

Catering: There are no catering facilities on site, although bottled water will be available. Please bring a packed lunch along with you for each team member.

Procedure: Couples are dancing in 2 classes. Class 1 and Class 2 according to their Classification scores, either combined for Duo or singular for Combi dance. Classification to take place at the Sports Hall from 9.00am - 11.00am on the morning of competition. Unless previous classification was made permanent, all athletes must attend in the wheelchair they will compete in and must bring with them any necessary straps/belts etc. Re-classification needed if dancing in a different wheelchair, or if there is an alteration to existing condition.

Doping: Doping is forbidden in accordance with the IPC Anti-Doping Code.

Judging : A dance couple is judged by at least 3 independent judges, according to judging criteria which can be found on websites.

Entry: Competitors: £10.00.pp. Visitors: £10.00 pp. Payable with a completed application form.

Teams paying in advance will receive £1 pp refund, paid back to the team.

Liability: The organisers are not responsible for any personal injury or damage to property.
